

CAMP CRAFT: Glow-in-the-Dark Light Bulb

This week at Camp Save-a-Watt, we'll be learning about the power of circuits and the invention of the light bulb. This craft is a fun way for you to make your own and use the power of the sun to make your light bulb shine.

Supplies needed:

- Thick paper or cardstock
- Glue

- Aluminum foil
- Glow-in-the-dark paint
- Cotton balls

Print out the Light Bulb printable on thick cardstock. Glue the cotton balls to the paper.

Cut or tear a piece of aluminum foil for the bottom part of the bulb and glue to the paper.

Paint the cotton balls with the glow-in-the-dark paint.

After the glue dries, power with the sun and you'll have some after dark artwork.
