

## PEC Interconnection Member Acknowledgement Form

I am the registered member for the account, and this is my acknowledgement that an interconnect application is being submitted by myself or on behalf of myself by the distributed generation (DG) solar installer of my choice.

### **Distributed Generation (DG) Interconnection Application Fees are as follows:**

I acknowledge fees associated with submitting an interconnect application

- Tier I: For systems with an aggregated nameplate capacity **less than 50 kW (AC)** in size, the following fees apply: \$500 plus actual cost of system upgrades when applicable
- Tier II: For systems with an aggregated nameplate capacity equal to or greater than 50 kW (AC), but less than 1 MW in size, the following fees apply: \$700, plus actual cost of the engineering study coordination and system upgrades when applicable
- Tier III: For systems with an aggregated nameplate capacity equal to or greater than 1 MW, but less than 10 MW in size: \$2500, plus actual cost of the engineering study coordination and system upgrades
- System Expansion, capacity after expansion, **less than 50 kW (AC): \$250**
- System Expansion, capacity after expansion, **equal to or greater than 50 kW (AC)**, but less than 1 MW: \$700, plus actual cost of the engineering study coordination and system upgrades when applicable
- All Interconnection Fees will be posted to the applicant's PEC account and invoiced within the monthly consumption bill at the time of approval of an interconnect application; fees will be visible on the member's following month's consumption bill.
- *Please note:* Multiple visits to complete a site inspection may result in a \$100 miscellaneous Trip Fee. For members, fees may apply when adding solar panels or battery backup to an existing DG system that has already completed the interconnection process.
- For applications that require an engineering study, all fees will be at cost. Results from studies may require system upgrades to accommodate the interconnection request. All upgrades required will be as per [PEC's Tariff and Business Rules](#).
- PEC Tariff and Business Rules:

\_\_\_ I have read the Interconnection Policy in the [PEC Tariff and Business Rules](#), including Fee Schedule(s) and rate information and understand they are subject to

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change at any time upon approval from PEC's Board of Directors; I also understand these changes may affect my account and impact any payback analysis prepared for the proposed distributed generation (DG) system which is in accordance with PEC's governing polices.

## Rate options:

PEC members with Distributed Generation (DG) at their Residential or Small Power location will be placed on the Sustainable Power Credit as the default rate. If the Interconnect Time of Use (TOU) rate is preferred, please contact Member Relations at 888-554-4732 after permission to operate has been granted by PEC.

### 1. Standard Interconnection Rate

- a. The account is charged the Flat Base Power Charge for all usage at the location and credited for all surplus generation at the Sustainable Power Credit. This credit be applied toward Flat Base Power Charges, and any unused credits expire at the end of each calendar year.

### 2. Time-of-Use Interconnection Rate

- a. The account is charged the Time-of-Use Base Power Charge for all usage at the location and the cost of power varies based on the time of day and season during which energy is consumed. The account is credited for all surplus generation at the Time-of-Use Base Power Credit and credit amount varies based on the time of day and season in which the surplus energy is generated. This credit will be applied toward Time-of-Use Base Power Charges, and any unused credits expire at the end of each calendar year. This rate plan requires a 12-month commitment before the account is eligible to switch to the Standard Interconnection rate.

PEC's current rate for each charge and credit listed above can be reviewed in the Rates section of the [PEC Tariff and Business Rules](#). Please note, rate change requests are not retroactive, and billing adjustments will not be offered.
